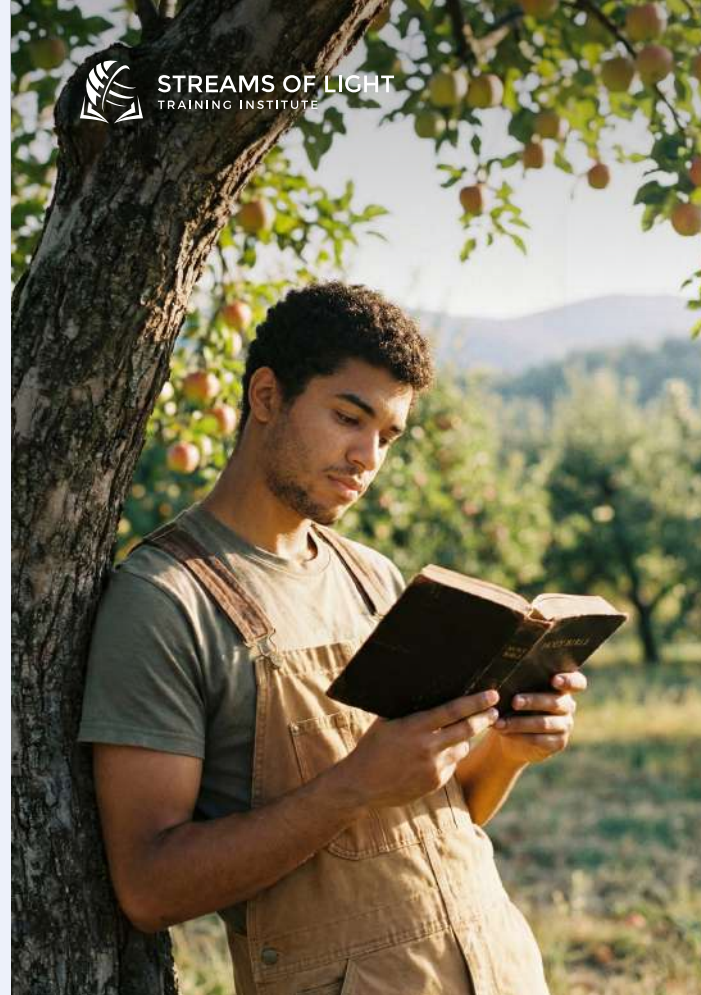

Commercial Farming & Agricultural Apprenticeship Program

Training Farmers for Mission, Stewardship, and Excellence

The Commercial Farming & Agricultural Apprenticeship Program is a hands-on, faith-based, agricultural training pathway that integrates practical farming skills, farm operations, and mission service. The program is grounded in biblical principles and the writings of Ellen G. White, particularly Counsels on Agriculture, and

is designed to prepare students for meaningful work in agriculture while using farming as a tool for mission and stewardship.

This is not a classroom-based program. Training takes place on a working farm through an apprenticeship-style model, with the majority of instruction occurring through **paid, hands-on field training**. Students learn by doing—gaining real-world experience under guided mentorship while actively participating in farm operations and responsibilities.
